College Credit

Equals # of hours class meets per week

Ex. College Algebra - 3 credit hours

Can meet M - W - F 1 hour

Tues and Thurs 1 ½ hours

Or Wednesday 3 hours

Typical college students take 15 credit hours per semester

High School Credit

.5 credit per course for electives and 1 credit for most core classes
