FORT MYERS VS THEIR OPPONENTS

For 47 years Fort Myers High School had the only team in Lee county. That changed beginning in 1967 with the addition of Cypress Lake and North Fort Myers High Schools. Fort Myers won its first 9 county games before losing in 1972 to North Fort Myers by the score of 14-0.

The longest continuous annual county opponent is Cypress Lake. The Greenies and the Panthers have played 40 consecutive years. This is tied for the longest streak of any annual opponent. Fort Myers and Sarasota also played 40 consecutive seasons (1935-1974)! North Fort Myers dropped Fort Myers from their schedule in 1970 and 1971.

In 40 years of county competition, Fort Myers has been County Champions 21 times and Tri-Champions 4 times. The Greenies have 5 distinguishable records when it comes to county competition. Besides the most county championships (25), the Greenies have the most consecutive county titles (7) 1986-1992, the highest county winning percentage .842, the most county wins 154, and the longest consecutive county-game winning streaks-26 (1986-1991) and 25 (2002-2006) !!!
