## Class of 2024

### ATTENTION: Parents of Seniors

The Federal Student Aid ID (FSA ID) allows students and parents to identify themselves electronically to access FSA websites, including the FAFSA website. An FSA ID is the fastest way to sign your application and have it processed and it's the only way to access or correct your information online.

#### NOTE:

- Parents and students need to create separate FSA IDs.
- Separate email addresses will be needed for parents and students to complete the process.
- If you have a FAFSA PIN from a previous year filing FAFSA, you must still create an FSA ID this year.

#### WHAT TO DO:

- Go to [fafsa.ed.gov](https://fafsa.ed.gov) and click on "FSA ID" link at the top (the link looks like a blue padlock).
- Click the green "Create an FSA ID Now" in the center of the page.
- Enter an email address
  - confirm the email address

- enter a username and password
- confirm password
- click "I am 13 years of age or older"
- click "Continue."
- A new page will pop up requesting information, including social security number, date of birth, and first and last names. Enter the information and click "Continue."
- Check that all information is correct. Next, enter your mailing address, city, state, ZIP code, phone numbers and language preference and click "Continue."
- Select and create challenge questions and answers and click "Continue."

**NOTE:** the significant date challenge question answer **cannot** be the individual's birthday.

- Verify all the information
  - click the box to certify correct information, accept Terms & Conditions, click "Continue."
- A Secure Code will be sent to the email address used to sign up. This is to verify the email address. Students, do NOT use

your school email.  
**Make sure** to open a new tab or window browser.  
**Do not** close out of the current browser window—that Secure Code will be entered into the box.

- An email will be sent to confirm that the FSA ID was created successfully.
- A separate email will contain the Secure Code. Enter the Secure Code into the box on the FSA ID website page.
- **Save your FSA ID and password for future use. Suggestion: make a "note" in your cell phone and enter your information** there for safekeeping. It will be used each year you file for FAFSA and all FSA websites.

### Cap & Gown Information

Herff-Jones was on campus November 1 to meet with the Class of 2024 and discuss cap and gown orders for our commencement ceremony. Their representatives returned on November 15 to collect in-person orders. All graduates who did not order in-person and still need to place their order must now order online. All students must register on [www.gradproinc.com](http://www.gradproinc.com) prior to ordering.

Early Bird Pricing is available until December 15th. After December 15th, the Early Bird Pricing will no longer be available and shipping costs will increase. These costs will continue to increase as the final order deadline of February 15th approaches. The February 15th order deadline is firm.

Cap and gown packages ship to FMHS and will be handed out a couple of weeks prior to Graduation in May. The basic package is the minimum that must be ordered for students purchasing a cap and gown package. Anything else is additional and not required. The cost of this package is \$64.60 plus any added tax and shipping/handling fees – which we anticipate will come out to \$85.79 total.

To order your cap and gown package online, visit: <https://gradproinc.com/> and select "shop senior graduation products" – then select Fort Myers High School. To find the basic package, select Shop Individual Items at the bottom of the page. Then, select Cap, Gown, & Tassel Unit. Be sure to enter the correct height and weight. When purchasing online, you can select Free Shipping & Handling and the cost comes out to \$70.79.

Seniors who plan to wear an older sibling's cap and gown must still purchase the Bare Essentials package, which is available on the Grad Pro website. To purchase the Bare Essentials package, visit: <https://gradproinc.com/> and select "shop senior graduation products" – then select Fort Myers High School. To find the basic package, select Shop Individual Items at the bottom of the page. On the next page, scroll to the bottom and click on page 4. Locate the item that says "BE" at the bottom of the page. This will include their FMHS stole and 2024 tassel.

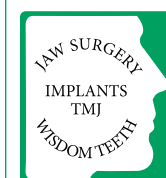

## Bright Futures Scholarship Requirements

The Bright Futures scholarship is available to any student who meets the requirements. The requirements are outlined in the Chapter 1: Initial Eligibility document on the Bright Futures website. This document can be found at: <https://www.floridastudentfinancialaidsg.org/PDF/BF-HandbookChapter1.pdf>

Below are the remaining test opportunities for seniors to meet the score for Bright Futures eligibility. Further details on how to register can be found on the ACT and SAT websites.

Students can begin earning volunteer service hours or paid work hours in 9th grade and all hours must be completed and submitted to their School Counselor by graduation. There are copies of the required paperwork in the School Counseling office and posted on the FMHS website. Hours must be pre-approved to ensure the service or paid work will meet the requirements. All details about what can and cannot qualify are outlined in the Bright Futures paperwork packet. Students should reach out to their School Counselor if they have questions.


